
## £21K PUWER Fine Following Severed Finger



## Understanding PUWER (Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations)

## **PUWER Prosecution**

A recent prosecution explores how an export services company received a fine of £21k after Health & Safety failings.

An incident in 2019 saw an employee severe his left index finger. His finger came to blow with an unguarded part of a saw blade. The radial saw was being used to cut wooden batons.

Further to this, the HSE investigation shows failings concerning the maintenance of the guard. This refers directly to the adjustable front guard on the arm saw. More over, the wings nuts and the rendering guard previously showed faults, and so unusable in the eyes of the HSE.
