Barriers

Generally used at commercial premises, schools and colleges for access control, rising barriers can also be used to combat unauthorised parking at residential developments and various other situations.

Low in maintenance and offering long term reliability, rising barriers could be the answer to your problems.



Available in different length booms to suit the width of the entrance, barriers are a cost effective measure to prevent parking spaces being taken up by commuters and shoppers, and can be operated by coded keypads, fobs, and intercoms by authorised persons only.



All of our entry and exit solutions are also compatible with our rising bollards, and work in conjunction with the relevant safety devices supplied with the installation to help prevent the bollard rising whilst a vehicle is passing over.



Rising Bollards

The perfect solution for compact driveway spaces where a gate is just not an option and prevention of your car being stolen is your objective, or for traffic management/access control, our rising bollards prove an effective deterent to the opportunist.

Operating either electro mechanically or hydraulically, automatic bollards come as a pre-wired unit that we install directly into the ground and wire to a control panel via ducting.



School, Commercial & Farm Gates



Entry & Exit Systems

The security that comes with being able to control who comes in via your gate, along with the ability to verbally and visually confirm their identity is immeasurable. Coded keypads and push buttons also make for useful exit devices, particularly if you'd only want just one gate leaf to open partially to allow pedestrians to get out (such items can be used as a form of entry too).



VIDEX GSM INTERCOM

Our most popular entry system is the GSM intercom. It houses a SIM card, and rather than having an internal handset installed within your property, the GSM intercom will ring your landline and / or mobile phone. This gives you flexibility to know there is someone at the gates, even if you're not at the property!

We also offer app based, colour video intercom systems, that are hardwired directly into your router. You can choose whether you use just your mobile to control the gate, or if you wish to have an indoor screen for when you're at the property.

For a swift and easy exit, we can install a ground loop, which acts like a metal detector. It detects when a car is approaching the gate, and will automatically send a signal to the control board to the gate to open - this way, you don't have to rummage around looking for the remote, or need to leave the vehicle!

Get The Right Look

A major factor in choosing whether to have your new gates handcrafted completely in hardwood or metal, or even a combination of those mediums will no doubt be based on the style of your property, and the reason you need them.


Metal gate designs tend to comprise of rods, bars, circles and fleur-de-lis in various patterns. These gates create a strong, secure entrance to your driveway, allowing you to see out, and passers-by to see in. This is great if you prefer not to feel isolated from the outside world. Designs can be aesthetically elegant or more industrial in appearance.

Wooden gates appear chunkier and offer total privacy (solid fully-boarded gate design). Alternatively, you can have a half-and-half design (solid fully-boarded at the bottom, with pales in the upper half), which will provide you with some visibility from your property, and a restricted view in from passers by.

A combination of metal frame with your choice of hardwood, composite (wood grain effect) or aluminium boards is another option available.

The amount of maintenance you're prepared to do may also be something to consider. For example, are you happy to treat a hardwood gate once a year, or would you prefer practically maintenance free metal / combination gates?
