Twelve key areas of focus to improve cow mobility

(Compiled by Ger Cusack MVB MRCVS)

- 1 Mobility Scoring**
Identify lame cows that require treatment/trimming early. Early treatment is key to recovery.
- 2 Recording Lameness**
Record each case of lameness and the cause e.g. (Mortellaro, white line disease). Your hoof trimmer or vet can help with this.
- 3 Risk Assessment**
Take a strategic look at your farm to identify areas for improvement to reduce the incidence of lameness.
- 4 Footbathing**
Utilise a comprehensive footbathing protocol that is specific to the issues present on farm.
- 5 Stress-free handling**
Reduce pressures during movement and allow animals to move at their own pace (no sticks, shouting, quads, etc.)
- 6 Space**
Ensure your animals have sufficient space in collecting yards, roads and housing.
- 7 Environment**
Improve the quality of surfaces on roadways and yards. Give cows a clean, dry environment for walking, both indoor and outdoor.
- 8 Cubicles**
Reduce standing times for animals by ensuring sufficient cubicles (1:1 cubicle per cow). Correct cubicle size and comfort, and minimising holding time in collecting yard.
- 9 Flow**
Identify problems with cow flow (e.g. sharp turns, overcrowding, narrow passages, etc.) Try to rectify these if possible. Get advice from your vet/hoof trimmer.
- 10 Lameness Control Plan**
Create a plan in conjunction with your vet/hoof trimmer outlining guidelines for the monitoring, treating and prevention of lameness in your herd.
- 11 Introduction of Heifers**
Introduce heifers to the herd well before calving. This will reduce fighting with dominant cows and reduce stress on heifer hooves.
- 12 Extra Care**
Give extra care to the freshly calving cow. She is very vulnerable to developing lameness in the immediate post-calving period. Keep calving cows near for a minimum of 48 hours and avoid walking long distances.

Method of disinfection

Footbathing is best used as a disinfection method after sheep are already gathered, for example; following shearing or scanning. Avoid gathering sheep solely to footbath, as this can increase the risk of spreading infection.

When to footbath

After gathering, run sheep through the footbath before returning them to the field.

Aftercare

Allow sheep to stand on a firm, dry surface for a few minutes so the solution can dry and work more effectively.

Important

Do not use formalin on ewes with CODD, it can cause severe pain due to exposed tissue.

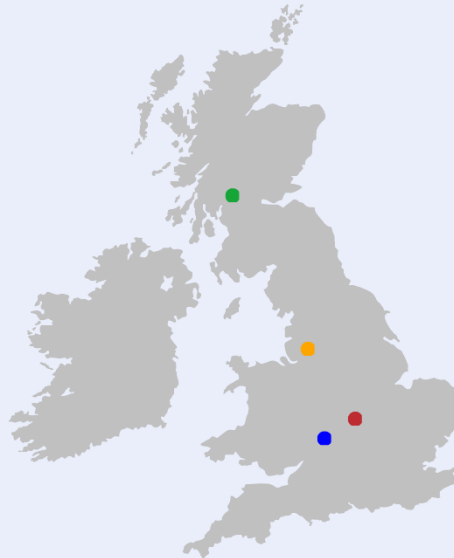

Dia-Care Electrolyte Effervescent Application:

Dissolve 1 pill in 1 litre of water.
Give to the calf 2 x per day - for up to 7 days.
A typical dose is for 3 days
Stop after scour has stopped and hydration is normal.

Always feed the calves with electrolyte separately from milk and as the calves require additional fluid and energy to replace loss
