Beyond security, custom lanyards also help build a sense of unit pride and identity. Lanyards featuring unit badges, squadron crests, or ship names create a sense of belonging that's always been part of military culture.

Lanyard Use Across All Branches of the Armed Forces

All branches of our British Armed Forces can benefit from professionally printed custom lanyards. Each branch of our military has strict security requirements, and lanyards help to form part of that security-first environment by allowing for clearly displayed identification. In practice, they are often used to help identify personnel, contractors, and visitors in busy or shared environments.

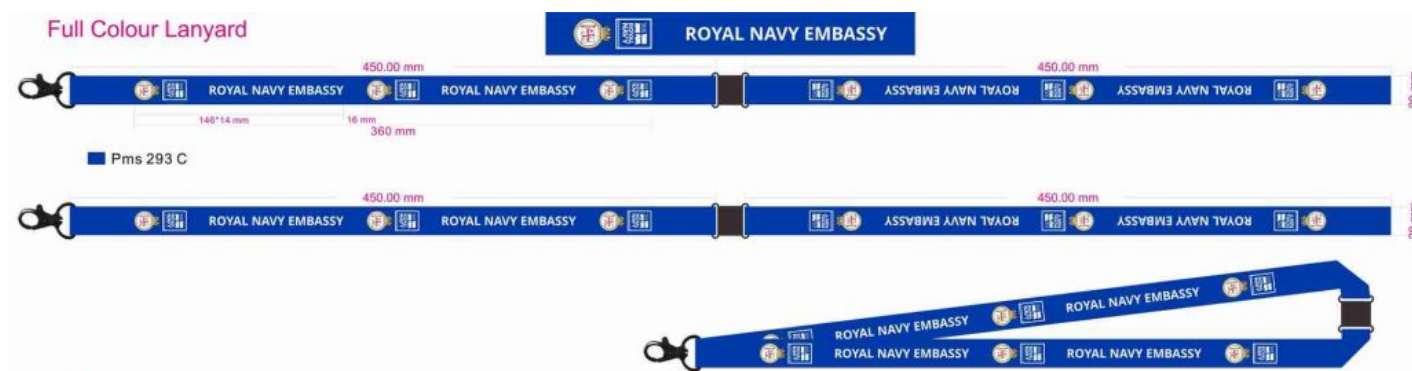
Common uses include:

- **Visitor management**, where guests need to be clearly identified, letting staff know they should be accompanied
- **Contractor access**, especially important on sites with civilian staff working alongside military personnel.
- **Events and public engagement**, where it's important to differentiate staff who may not be in uniform from civilians.
- **Training environments**, where instructors, trainees, and support staff might all be working together.
- **Office and headquarters** settings, where staff often have access to confidential files or sensitive information and may need to display their credentials.

Royal Navy Lanyards

The Royal Navy works across ships, shore establishments, and overseas locations, so durability matters. On board ship, a lanyard should be practical, comfortable, and safe to wear in tighter working spaces. Our lanyards all include safety breaks as a standard.

Additionally, many naval units choose lanyards that reflect the vessel, ship name, or emblem. That can help build identity without sacrificing the professional appearance expected on board or ashore. Naval bases and dockyards may also include a mix of military staff, contractors, and visitors. Clear lanyards and ID holders can help make access control easier in those environments.



RAF Lanyards

The Royal Air Force works across a number of major UK stations, including RAF Brize Norton, RAF Lossiemouth, RAF Coningsby, and RAF Cranwell. These are large, active sites where clear identification supports daily operations, training, and event security.

Squadrons often choose custom lanyards featuring their badge, number, or station branding to create a consistent and professional look. At places like Cranwell, where training and administration are both important, lanyards can help distinguish between instructors, trainees, support staff, and visitors.

They are also useful at open days and air shows, where staff, contractors, media, and guests need to be identified quickly and clearly.

Additionally, the RAF sometimes operates from joint civilian and military airbases, where identifying military personnel is key.

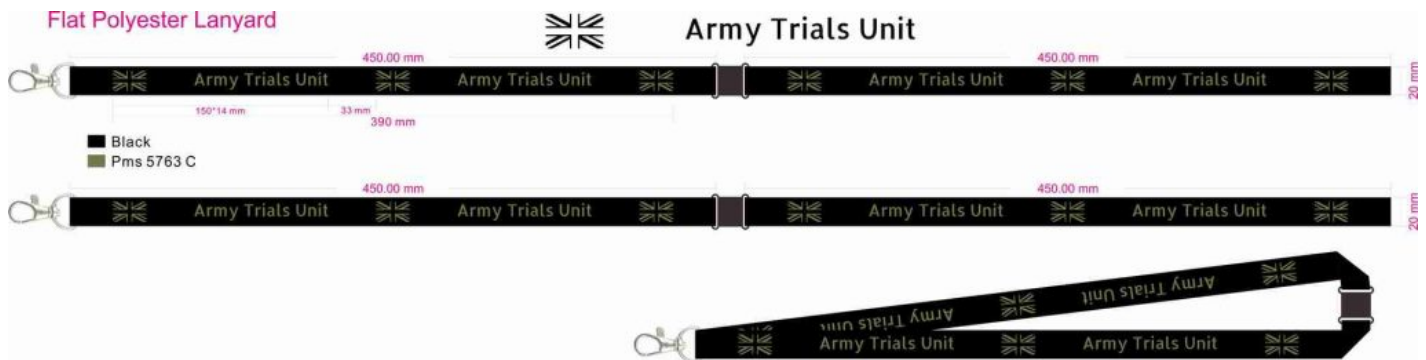


Army Lanyards
