## How to clean, care and get the most out of your divider?

When you are scouting for any type of investment or purchase you want to make sure that you get the best product of a good value to make a productive and worthy use of your hard earned wages.

As we know large products can over time pick up large amounts of asmophereical residue like dust and all sorts of germs and bacteria, to help with this problem this blog provides information on how to properly care for our products and how to clean each surface, which is the key to have a humble divider live up to its fullest potential for all its lifetime.

## Polycarbonate & Clearview Dividers

The best way to clean a smoother surface like polycarbonate is to use a mild soap such as washing up liquid and a cloth or sponge. To prevent damaging the divider stay away from stronger products that are alcohol based, this is the easiest and safest way to make sure the surface is kept clean and undamaged chemically. You may also use antibacterial wipes and spray for further disinfecting.

## Fabric Dividers

With regards to dust and dry debris it would be best to use a vacuum with strong suction for maximum cleaning. To keep your room divider looking professional and in tip top shape, <u>acoustical partitions</u> and more fabric dividers will require spot cleaning regularly. To do this you need to use a dampened cloth with a mild water based soap and water solution, lightly brush the area and avoid soaking the panels in the solution. To dry the area we would recommend using a towel. If you are using a fabric cleaner always test it on the fabric in an inconspicuous area before using on a more prominent part of the divider just to make sure no further damage will occur. (The same applies for <u>SoundSorb</u> materials.)

Make sure to try and remove stains ASAP if possible for best results

Clean regularly to avoid dirt buildup
