Slinger / Signaller ALLMI Qualification for the Driver of Lorry Loader Crane vehicles and their Assistant / Drivers Mate.

A recommended qualification for also using other types of lifting equipment on-site or in yards, compounds and sites or distributions centres and branches.

Training starts with an over view of the Legislation affecting lorry loaders, with emphasis on the role of the Slinger / Signaller including the law surrounding pre- and post-operational checks of lifting accessories, and how such checks should be carried out and documented. As well as the law surrounding pre- and post-operational checks of lifting accessories, and how such checks should be carried out and documented. Training includes understanding the key principles for selection and safe use of the different types of lifting accessory available. And learning good practice for storing and maintaining the different types of lifting accessory available and the different methods of signalling, including industry-standard hand signals whilst maintaining a safe position for clear and effective signalling.

Then taking what has been learnt in the theory session on slinging, we then progress applying it to practical training and scenarios, and preparing candidates for the end of training Assessments. Once the candidate has reached the satisfactory standard, and passed their Assessment, the candidate will be registered and receive a certificate and ALLMI card confirming they have attained their qualification.
